

## **HOWELL TOWNSHIP CEMETERIES**

### **PIONEER CEMETERY**

Pioneer Cemetery also known as the Marr Cemetery and the oldest cemetery in Howell Township is located on Burkhart Road, just north of Marr Rd. Around 1848 the Marr family designated the property to be a burial site. The land was deeded to Howell Township in 1866.

Improvements are being made on the lower west end of the unused part of cemetery. There are plans also to put in a well and a hand pump for watering purposes only.

Cemetery plots remain the same price as last year, Resident \$300.00, Infant-24 months or less \$200.00, Non-resident \$800.00

### **FLEMING CEMETERY**

Fleming Cemetery also known as West Howell Cemetery is located on Fleming Rd. just one half mile from what was once called the "Six Corners of Fleming". The cemetery was laid on what was then the Van Nest property around 1850. The cemetery was officially established around 1899. There are no longer any plots available in Fleming Cemetery but many of the township's early settlers are buried in this cemetery.

We ask that you please remember to remove any flowers, blankets, etc that are not in healthy condition. It is recommended that winter items be removed by May 1<sup>st</sup> and Summer items be removed by November 1<sup>st</sup>. Our maintenance crew is not available December thru March.
